**\*Dates listed on this sheet pertain to specifically notable, better date/mintmark coins, as a “what to look out for” helpful \*general\* guide meant to differentiate between those listed on the Common Buy Sheet,**

**\*but does not exclude the potential for a coin to be worth more than “usual” due**

**to some other characteristic.**

**\* Some date/mintmarks are more highly valued than others and are priced according to their condition/grade. Dates listed on this sheet may be worth double-checking, but depending on condition, it may or may not be bought above the regular common buy price.**

**\*Dates/mintmarks in BOLD letters are more notably better, as opposed to ones that are not bolded are only slightly better when in average condition.**

**\*Some dates that are not listed here may be bought at higher prices than listed on the Common Buy Sheet, particularly if they are in a higher than average condition.**

**“ \* ”- Notes a Double Die Obverse, Double Die Reverse, Overdate, or other characteristic that differs it to a regular mintage coin of that date and mintmark. Regular mintage issues would not be “better” unless also specifically noted.**
